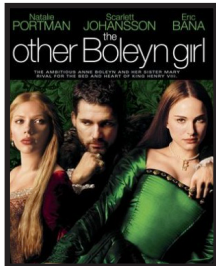


## April Movie Matinee *Cascade Room, Wednesday, 1-3:30 p.m.*

Watch afternoon movies with a monthly theme and join an informal discussion afterward. English subtitles are available.

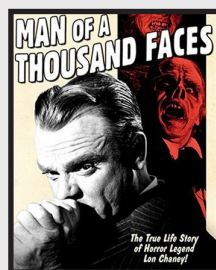
April Theme: James Cagney

**Biographical Drama, G, 107 minutes**

Growing up with deaf parents, Lon Chaney learns what being different is like; as an actor, he puts that knowledge, along with lots of makeup and talent, to use playing a variety of strange and unique characters.



### April 22: **One, Two, Three (1961)**

**Comedy, G, 107 minutes**

In Cold War-era West Berlin, Coca-Cola executive Mac MacNamara must manage his boss's daughter. When she secretly marries an East German communist, Mac scrambles to fix everything before chaos erupts.
